Topic: Shapes Subtopic: 2D shapes Activity type/skill: Text prediction Literacy focus: Reading Genre: Instructions

Objective

- Recall vocabulary relating to shapes.
- Predict what might be in a written text giving instructions.

What you need

Student worksheet (see next page)

What to do

- 1. Look at the student worksheet and talk about the picture of the windmill.
- 2. Ask students what they need to know to make a windmill like this.
- 3. Work together to produce an outline on the board of what might be in a text giving instructions, for example:
 - a title plus a picture or description of what you are going to make
 - a list of things you need
 - a list of what you have to do, in sequence
 - illustrations showing what to do step by step.
- 4. Have students copy the outline on their worksheet.
