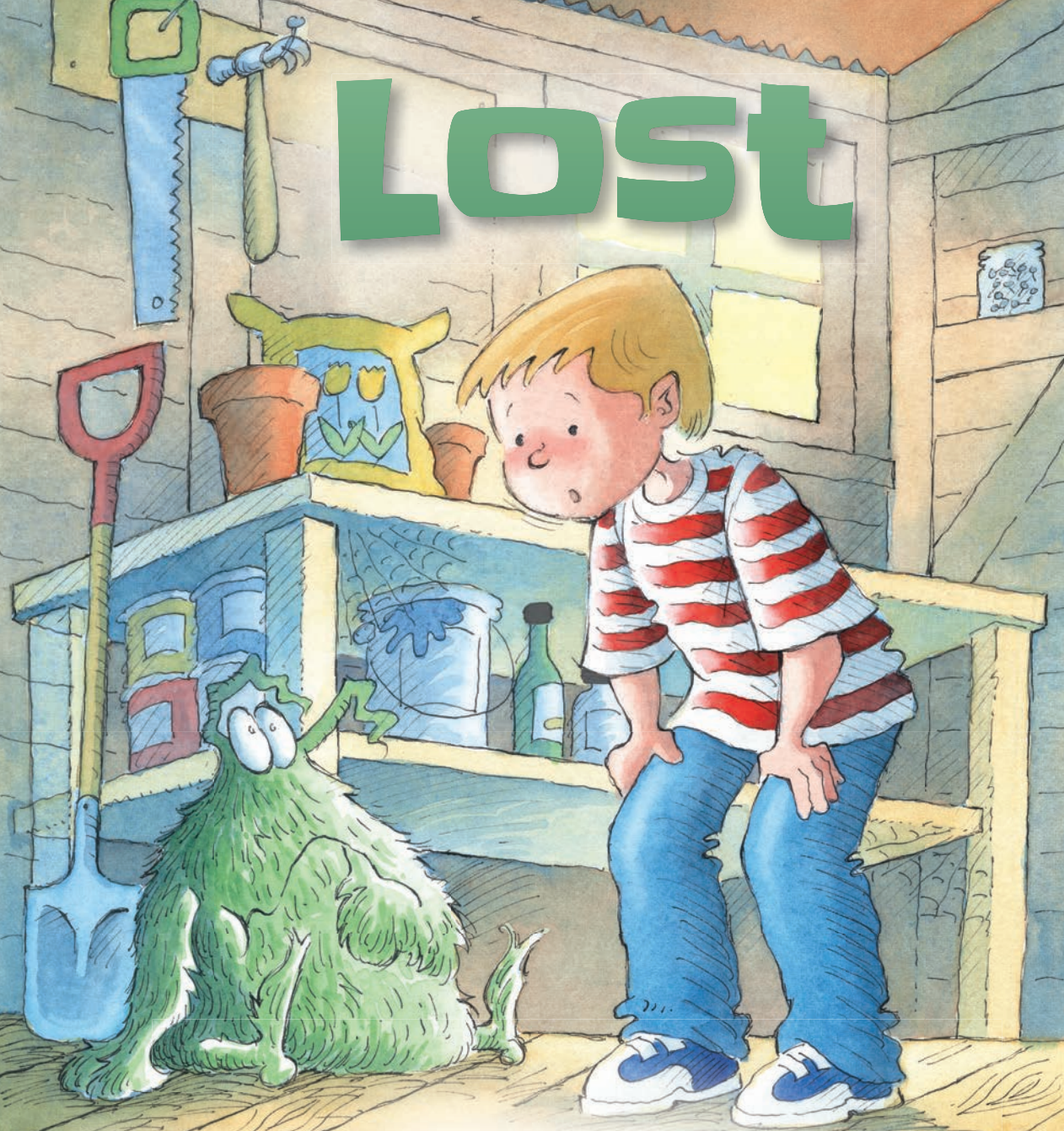

and has feelers on its head.”

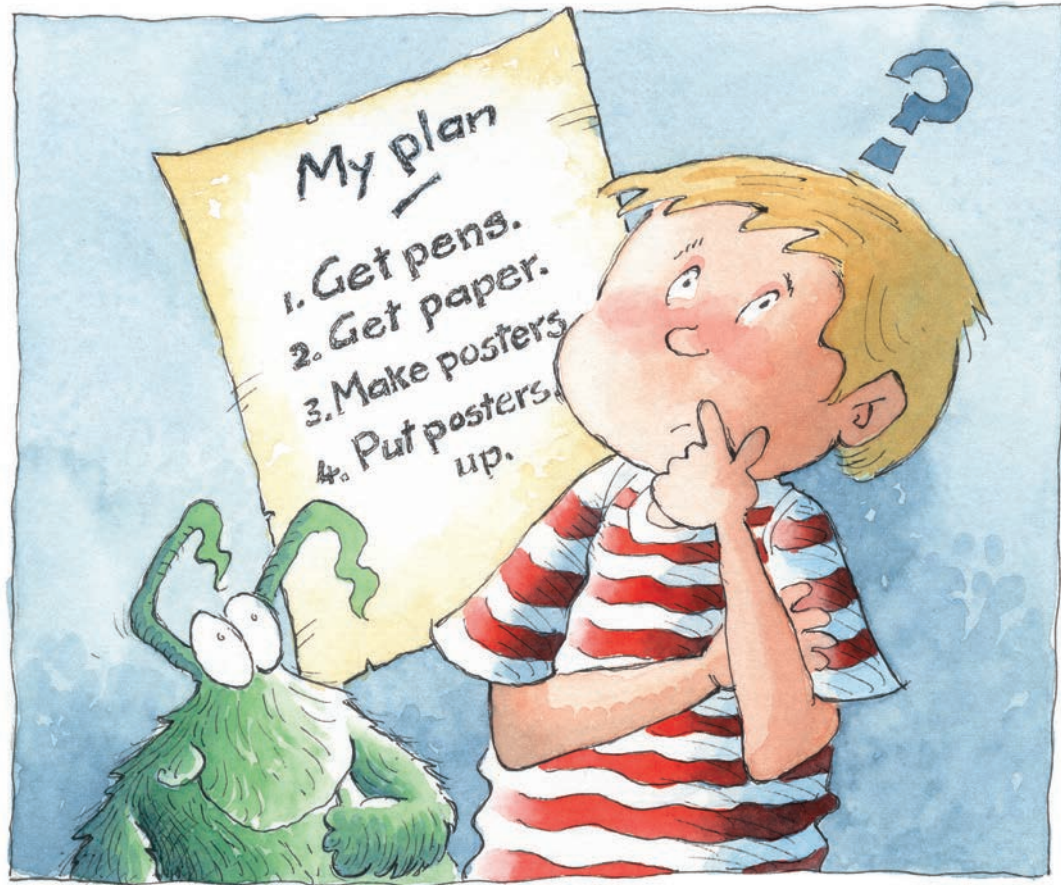
“A creature?” said Mum.

“I’ll leave it up to you.”

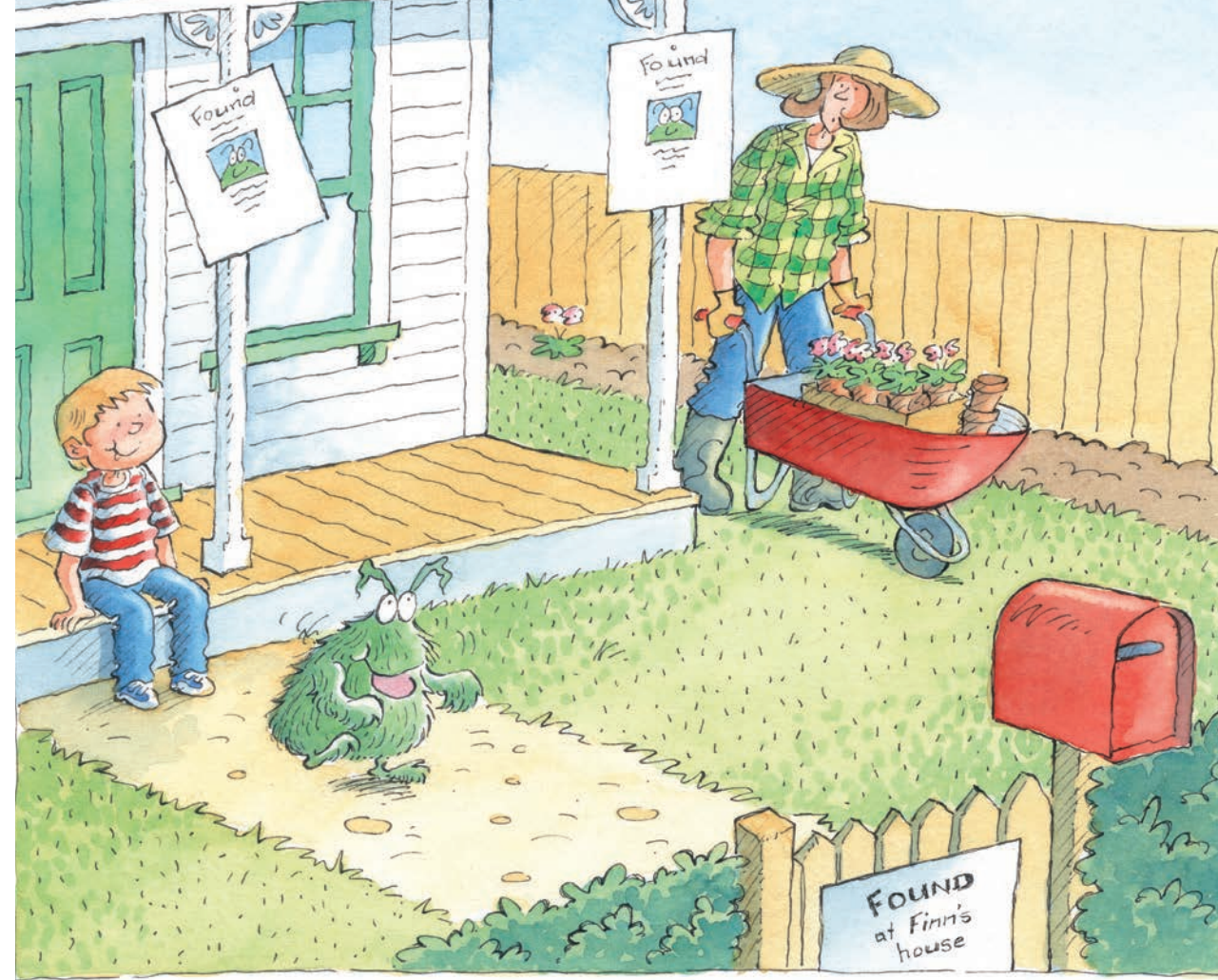
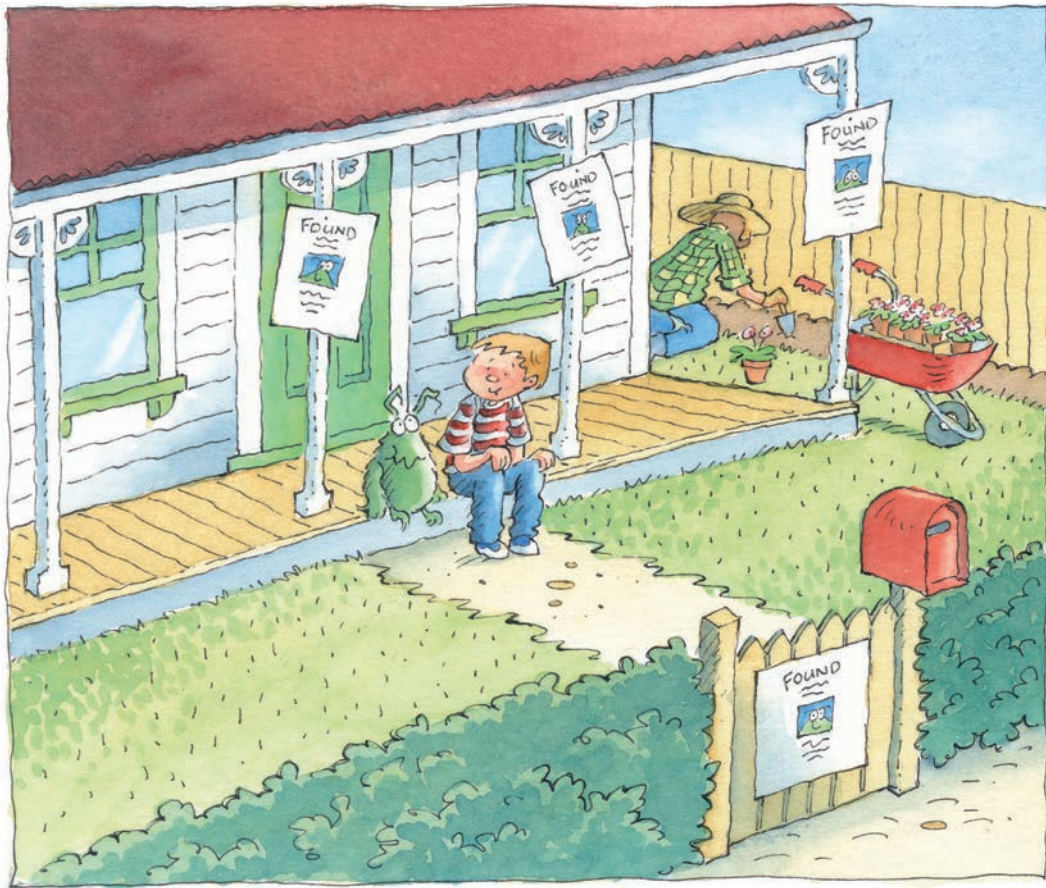




So Finn thought and thought.
