

Grammar Scope

Nouns:

- Proper nouns e.g. Jose, Ji
- Common nouns e.g. hair, eyes, face
- Singular e.g. face, eye
- Plural eyes
- Count
- Non-count e.g. hair

Prepositions:

- Of place next to, in, on etc., e.g. next to me

Articles:

- Definite the, e.g. the person
- Indefinite a, an, e.g. a striped t-shirt

Pronouns:

- Subject he, it, etc., e.g. He has very short black hair.
- Possessives his, my, your, her etc., e.g. his shoes, his face
masculine/feminine/(his/her)
(1st, 2nd, 3rd person – singular and plural)

Demonstratives:

this, that, these, those etc., e.g. This boy's name is Jose.

Simple conjunctions:

and, (additive) but, or, (contrastive) because (reason)
etc., e.g. Ji lives in Napier and he comes from China.

Verbs:

- Simple present e.g. is, comes, speaks, has
- Negation e.g. He isn't tall.

Adjectives:

e.g. straight, short, black, tall, striped

Quantifiers:

very, some etc., e.g. very short hair

Punctuation:

e.g. full stops, commas, upper/lower case, question marks,
paragraphs

Simple contractions:

what's, I'm, he's, she's, e.g. What's his name?
