

Grammar Scope

Nouns:

- Proper nouns e.g. Frost
- Common nouns e.g. man, sun

Articles:

- Definite the, e.g. the (sun's) rays
- Indefinite an, a, e.g. a man

Pronouns:

- Subject I, you, we, they etc., e.g. He melts
- Relative wherever, who, which etc., e.g. wherever he goes

Adjectives:

- e.g. white, tip, frosty, frozen

Adverbs:

- Of manner hard, etc., e.g. It was raining hard.

Question formation:

- 'wh' e.g. Why is the poem sad? What is the poem about?
- Subject reversal e.g. Is rain sad?

- 'do' support e.g. Does the frost melt in the sun?
- when no auxiliary e.g. Frost doesn't last in the sun.

Negation:

- e.g. Yes, she does. No, it doesn't.

- Present tense verbs e.g. is, melts

- e.g. apostrophes, question marks, upper/lower case, full stops, commas, lines, verses, stanzas, chorus
