Common nouns	e.g. beakers, water, marker pen, calculator
<b>Prepositions:</b>	
Of place	in, on etc., e.g. on the outside, in a warm place
Of accompaniment	with etc., e.g. with water, with algebraic logic
Of duration	for, since etc., e.g. for a few days
<b>Articles:</b>	
Definite	the, e.g. the beakers, the number
Indefinite	an, a, e.g. a foil cover
<b>Conjunctions:</b>	
Contrastive	or, but, although etc., e.g. or similar calculator
<b>Adjectives:</b>	
	e.g. both, warm, few, similar
<b>Question formation:</b>	
'wh'	e.g. What do you do first? When do you add the water?
Subject reversal	e.g. Is the water level the same?
'do' support when no auxiliary	e.g. Does the water level change?
Modal 'can'	e.g. Can you see a difference?
<b>Short answer forms:</b>	
	e.g. Yes, it does. No, it doesn't. Yes, it has. No, it hasn't. Yes, it is. No, it isn't.
<b>Imperative verbs:</b>	e.g. fill, put, leave, press, type, read
<b>Infinitive verbs:</b>	e.g. To find out about evaporation. How to use a calculator to find the square root of a number.
